- e) What is the 'final solution' that Mallika discovers for her predicament?
- f) Comment on the theme of homelessness and exile in the context of Partition.
- g) Comment on the literary representations of women during and after the partition of India.

h) Analyse the motifs of violence and communalism in the partition novels.
