Group-A

- ii) "I Cannot Live with You" is, on the one hand, a love poem, and on the other, an anti-love poem."—Discuss.

Group-B

- iii) How does Mahasweta Devi represent female body as a site of counter resistance in *Draupadi?*
- iv) Illustrate the life of the upper caste Hindu women of the nineteenth century as depicted in *Amar Jiban*.

2. Attempt any four of the following questions. $4\times5=20$

- i) "They'd judge us." Who are referred to as 'they' in the poem "I Cannot Live with You"? How did they judge?
- ii) Comment on the portrayal of the oppression of the women from Mahar community in Baby Kamble's *The Prisons We Broke*.
- iii) Can you consider "Daddy" as a confessional poem? Discuss with reference to the text.
- iv) Narrate in brief, Kamala Das's projection of conflict between English and vernacular languages in the field of Indian creative writings.
- v) Write, a brief, about Alice Walker's use of the device of letters in *The Color Purple*.
- vi) How does "Draupadi" challenge patriarchy?
- vii) Rassundari Devi uses religion 'to take away the sting from transgression'. Discuss.
- viii) Write a brief note on confessional poetry.

3. Attempt any <u>ten</u> of the following questions. $10\times2=20$

- i) What does the 'White Sustenance' stand for in the poem "I Cannot Live with You"?
- ii) Comment on Plath's use of the word 'black' more than once in the poem "Daddy".

- iii) What is the title of Baby Kamble's *The Prisons We Broke* in Marathi language? Who translated it into English?
- iv) Who wrote the book *Sextual Politics*? When was it published?
- v) Mention a few customs of patriarchal Indian society that forbid women to enjoy the bliss of liberty.
- vi) What do the cat's green eyes suggest in Eunice de Souza's poem?
- vii) Point out the linguistic dilemma of the speaker in Kamala Das's poem "An Introduction".
- viii) What is the two-fold significance of Celie's first letter in *The Color Purple*?
- ix) What are the three actions that indicate Celie's inner strength in *The Color Purple?*
- x) Who murdered Surya Sahu and why in "Draupadi"?
- xi) How did Senanayak motivate Captain Arjan Singh?
- xii) Who wrote the Forword to the 2nd edition of *Amar Jiban*? Mention any one point that he found praiseworthy in the autobiography.
- xiii) Mention two symbols/similes used by Rassundari Devi in *Amar Jiban* to depict the predicament of a child bride.

- xiv) How are the black women and Dalit women doubly marginalized?
- xv) Why is the speaker in "Daddy" 'scared' of her father?
