The Govt. Audit for the year 2019-20 has been completed. The Internal Audit for the year 2020-21 & 2021-22 completed and the Govt. Audit for the same years will be done after allotment of Audit Firm by the DPI, West Bengal.

Biodiversity Park

We are very happy to announce that the Dept. of Environment, Govt. of West Bengal has given the administrative approval and financial sanction of Rupees Nine Lakh Eighty Thousand Four Hundred (Rs. 9,80,400.00) for the project entitled "Development of a Biodiversity Park at the college campus of Raja Narendra Lal Khan Women's college" on 05-08-2021. The work is being carried out under the supervision of Dr. Anirban Roy, Research Officer, and West Bengal Biodiversity Board. We intend to set up a tree library, grassland mound, butterfly garden, ecopond, etc. within the Biodiversity Park.

Solar Tree

For the long-term use of green and clean energy, a solar tree has been installed within our college campus with the help of Durgapur CMERI (Central Mechanical Engineering Research Institute). The solar tree was inaugurated by the District Magistrate of Paschim Medinipur on 3rd of March, 2022. This 11.55 kW peak power solar tree has a total of 35 solar PV panels, each with a power of 330 watts and can produce 35-45 units of green and clean energy on typical sunny day. From the very beginning, total 7850 units already produced by the solar tree till 15th of August, 2022. This solar energy partially meets our institution's electricity need and a portion of the generated energy is fed into the power grid.

Construction of new Entry Gate

The Governing Body of our college decided to construct a new college entry gate to commemorate the autonomous status received by it from UGC. In this context we are very privileged and thankful to note that Mr. Sukamar Roy, Director, Ketek Pvt. Ltd. has donated Rs. 32,86,948.00 to construct the gate. The Construction work is almost finished, and expected to be completed before the 66th Foundation Day of the College.

Societal Activities by the College in the Surrounding Localities

- College has set up a purified drinking water system worth of Rs. 2,50,000.00 at Murakata Primary School & Muradanga Primary School, Kankabati Gram Panchayat, Paschim Midnapore. The system was inaugurated by the Principal with presence of some faculty members and staff of the college.
- College has donated 2 ceiling fans and 3 tube lights (20 wt.) to Muradanga Primary School this year.
- In January 2022, winter garments were distributed amongst the street children in Rangamati Area of Midnapore twon. This camp was jointly carried out by the dept. of Education and Balaka Alumni Association of the College.

 Poor but meritorious student Sunanda Pani, dept. of BMLT was financially supported by the Alumni Association of the College to continue her study. Rs. 12000.00 was spent in this part.

Since the last Foundation Day, our college has made significant progress in teaching, research and extension activities. Currently 12 Major Research Projects are active in different departments of the College. Numbers of quality research papers have been written by the faculty members.

Banamahotsav

Banamahotsav has been successfully celebrated this year on 14/07/2022 with the assistance of the Alumni Association "Balaka", and the NSS of this college. Despite the possibility of heavy rain, Teachers, Staff, and Students actively participated in the programme.

College Cooperative Credit Society Ltd.

The Staff Co-operative Credit Society of Raja N.L. Khan Women's College has been working effectively over years. The last Annual General Meeting of the Society was held on 25/03/2022. The total number of BOD Meeting held during this year is 12. At present, there are 107 (T.S. – 54, N.T.S. – 25, Hostel Staff – 06 and SACT – 22) members in the society. Total amount of loan given to the members in the financial year 2021-22 is Rs. 65,56,000.00 (Sixty-five lac fifty-six thousand).

College Land

Proposal for 99 years' extension (from 22/08/2017) of lease deed of college land was submitted with all requisite papers to the ADM & DLRO, Paschim Medinipur. The lease deed with the said extension is received this year.

Hostels

The College has six hostels at present. Nearly 500 boarders reside in these six hostels. Massive renovation work of the Pravabati Bhavan and Lavatories, and electrical repairing works of all the buildings have been done. A big kitchen has been constructed for hostel boarders. The old kitchen of the Nivedita Building has been transformed into the Hostel Common Room with all facilities. A big shed has been constructed this year which will be used as an additional dinning space. Recently, one cycle-stand and two stalls with readymade food items and stationery goods have been set up for the boarders inside the hostel premises.

Supply of Water in the Campus

The Supply of water in hostels, laboratories, and staff quarters is done by Public Health Engineering Department, Govt. of West Bengal. This department supervises the pumping of water from a big well, situated at Gope Nandini at a distance of 1.5 K.M. from the college, and water is stored in a huge overhead reservoir inside the college campus, from which water is

delivered. Beside this, another deep tube-well was installed inside the campus. However, during the summer season, our college campus often faces scarcity of water. The College Authority is grateful to Mr. Subrata Mukherjee, MIC, PHE & Panchayet and Rural Development for sanctioning of one deep tube-well and one Water ATM for this college. A water filter with capacity of 3000 lt. has been installed in the hostel last year with the assistance of the Dept. of Chemical Engineering, IIT, KGP, under the supervision of Prof. Sirsendu De. Two more water filters of 1500 lit. capacity mentioned above have been installed near Rabindra Neer and Controller Section this year.

Security of the Campus

A police outpost exists in the campus to maintain the security round the clock. Higher Education Department, Govt. of West Bengal allocates special fund to District Police Authority for the said purpose. Besides this, Security personnel have been engaged by the College at the Gate, round the clock. One new security person has been appointed this year.
